The Section is a union of 10 lodges across NC, SC, and GA that meet every year at Dixie to compete and engage in fellowship. Each year, three positions are elected to represent the Section at national events. These include the Section Chief, Section Vice-Chief, and Section Secretary. All 3

positions will be open and any Arrowman can run, so long as they are an active member of Tsali Lodge! In order to run, you must get approval from our Chief Scout Executive, Josh Christ.
