Tsali Patch Update

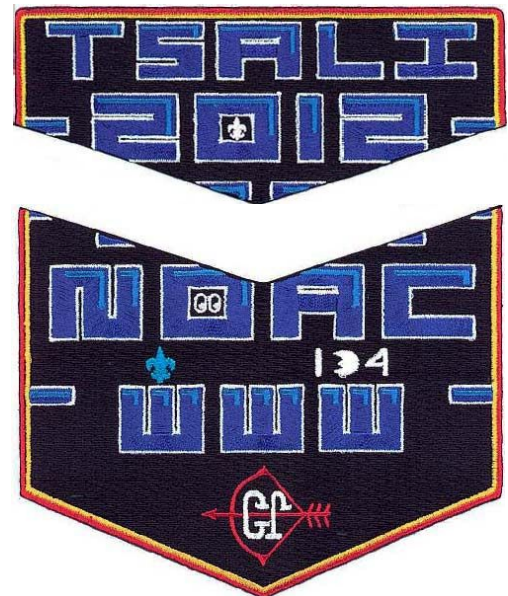

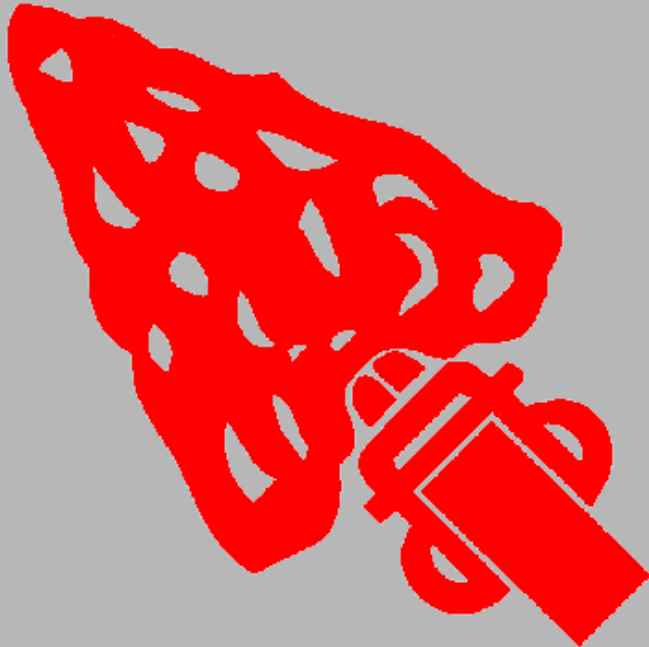
