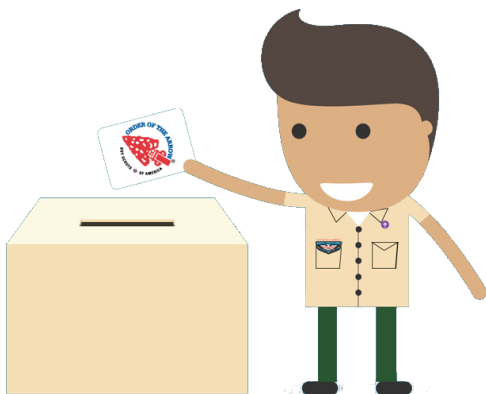
Winter Banquet

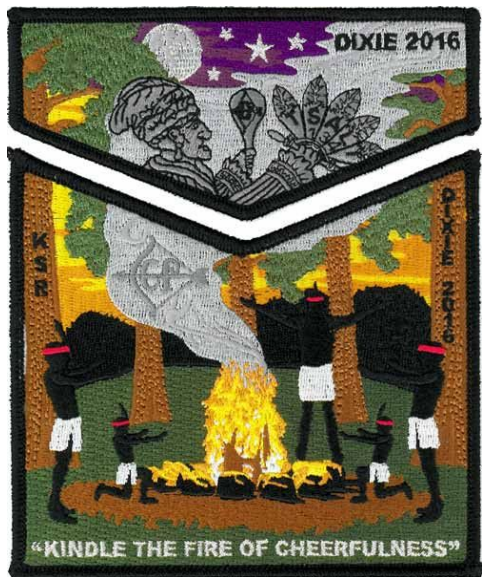
