Summer Ordeal

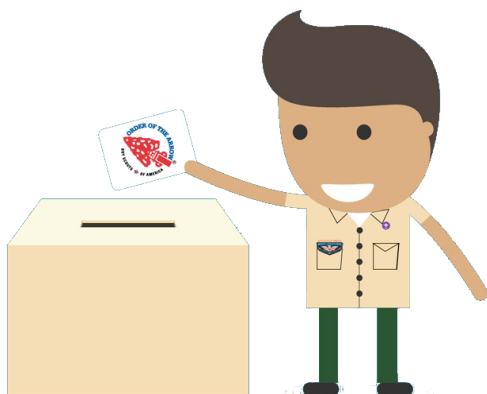
